Application of William J. Quibell No. 5956

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a PARDON and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of January A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William J. Quibell I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Leslie Vier

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Record Shows.
