I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of voluntary manslaughter.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the May day of A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable D. W. Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an intermediate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.
