I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in UTAH STATE PRISON
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary in the second degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of October
A. D. 1926, at Ogden City County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison for a term not less
than one year and not more than twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Cistobal Martinez
I was convicted under the name of Cistobal Martinez

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
