Application of John Adams No. 5082

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17 day of October
A. D. 1928, at Odgen County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable S. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of John Adams
