I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in ON PAROLE  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of October  
A. D. 1928, at Weber County of Ogden  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Five years to life in  
Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Sam Bond

I was convicted under the name of John Adams
