**Termination**

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a .....  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in ON PAROLE  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of Sept.  
A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Mc Kinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years in  
the Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for a  
period of one year. I was released on parole on  
the 25<sup>th</sup> of Sept. 1934

Fourth-Honorable Calvin H. Raulings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Alvie Sollis

I was convicted under the name of Alvie Sollis

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: William Davis

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except petty larceny  
April 1924. Third degree burglary, Jan. 29
