I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of June
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third (3rd) Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. R. Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ernest J. Gabriel
I was convicted under the name of Ernest J. Gabriel

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Walter Shirley

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except robbery for which
I sentenced to the New York State Reformatory at Elmira
N. Y. and petty larceny sentenced to the Salt Lake
County Jail, at Salt Lake City Utah.
