Application of Clifton O. Cook

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving owner of use of car

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of November
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable David W. Moffatt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Five Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Clifton O. Cook
I was convicted under the name of Clifton Cook
