Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of December,
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morrison Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
