Application of Red Gyllett No. 4177

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination Commutation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery & Murder 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of December, A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jessie L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable J. B. Stewart prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Red Gyllett I was convicted under the name of Red Gyllett

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: William R. Fox

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
