and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in On Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of March
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd. District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McKonkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 10 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
Paroled September 21, 1929

Fourth-Honorable Ray VanCott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Vernon Tanner

I was convicted under the name of Vernon Tanner
