Application of Christopher Columbus Nolan

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Statutory Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of October  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Christopher Columbus Nolan  
I was convicted under the name of Christopher Columbus Nolan

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: W. Wedell W. B. Updike

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
