Application of Jesse C. James

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of May  
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William McCrear presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
of from 1 to 20 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jesse Clarence James  
I was convicted under the name of Jesse C. James
