Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Fifth day of November  
A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Benjamin Candelario  
I was convicted under the name of Benjamin Candelario

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Do not know other man's name

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except  
One for Petty Larceny in Los Angeles, Cal.
