I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the fifth day of November  
A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Dist Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence  
of from one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison at  
Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph C. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Benjamin Candelario
