and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of April
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd. Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Clausen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Millard Bray Andrews
I was convicted under the name of Millard Andrews
