Application of Millward Andrew No. 5011

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20 day of April
A. D. 1928, at Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Earl Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Millward Bray Andrew
I was convicted under the name of M. B. Andrew

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
I am 18 years of age and ask
for leniency of the Board, I have
learned my lesson, I live in
Salt Lake City, and will have
a job as soon as I get out.
