To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the fifth day of April  
A. D. 1926, at Morgun City County of Logan  
and State of Utah, in in non-judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not more than three years  
and not less than six months  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on  
the fifth day of April A. D. 1926.

Fourth-- Honorable County atty C. C. Geary prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Herbert Biddle  
I was convicted under the name of Charles Herbert Biddle

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a check  
charge of insufficient funds resulting  
about 3 days in the County Jail
