Application of Elmer Wasson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State's Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of January A. D. 1926, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable -- Wright. presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the State's Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Elmer Wasson

I was convicted under the name of Elmer Wasson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Albert Wingate, Virgil Seward.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Offenses against military regulations. No civil crimes.
