Application of Elmer Hasson No. 4656

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of January A. D. 1926, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five Years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Le Roy Be Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elmer Hasson I was convicted under the name of Elmer Hasson.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Albert Hindgate - Virgil Sward.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except United States Disciplinary Barracks No Felonious Offense.
