Application of Ray Smith

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison.
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7 day of Nov.
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. A. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
of from 1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Ray Smith
I was convicted under the name of Ray Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Violation of
Mann Act for which I served six months
in Caribou County Jail at Soda Springs, Ida.
From March 11 1925 to Aug. 11 1925.
