I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Parole} ~~Special Hearing at May Meeting~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with intent to kill

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the Fifth day of December A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not to exceed five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Floyd Thomas Sandusky I was convicted under the name of Floyd Thomas Sandusky
