Application of Santon Basquez

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Deportation to Mexico
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 2th day of December
A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term, One to
Ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable Jos. C. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Santon Basquez
I was convicted under the name of Santon Basquez
