First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of November
A. D. 1932, at Salt Lake City County of Wasatch
and State of Utah, in 1st District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from one to ten
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable W. J. Levan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Walter Levan
