I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of November
A. D. 1931, at Boulder City County of Bear Elder
and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Serve term not to twenty
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Shelby K. Wesley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward Joseph Hansen
I was convicted under the name of Levanthalter

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Not apprehended

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except 1928 served
two years in San Quentin California
for 2nd degree Burglary, 1931 served
to years in the Utah State Prison
for Car theft
