and State of Utah, in 1st District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James Morris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to imprisonment on one to
ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Harley H. Hays prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Levan Hutter
