First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary 3rd degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of March
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. N. Kimble presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to six months to three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank Martinez
I was convicted under the name of Frank Martinez

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except what shows on record
