Application of Joseph Selis No. 5078

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or Condition and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of Oct A. D. 1928, at SALT LAKE CITY County of SALT LAKE and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge. Hannson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dunkan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph Selis I was convicted under the name of Joseph Selis
