Application of George Edward Alling

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of October A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of not less than six months and not more than three years in the State prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Fred B. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Edward Alling.

I was convicted under the name of George Edward Alling.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one herein referred to.

I was sent to the Colorado State Reform School, from Canon City, Colorado, for temporary auto theft, and larceny.
