I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parol  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the day of September  
A. D. 1927, at Manti County of Sanpete  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate term in the State  
Prison, of from one to ten years  
and thereafter was ~~imprisoned in the~~ granted a reprieve until March 16, 1929.  
on which date the said reprieve was extended for one month, and per-  
mission granted to apply for a parol.

Fourth-Honorable John A. Hougaard prosecuted the case.
