Application of Jefferson B. Newman No. 4613

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole or Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with deadly weapon

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixteen day of October
A. D. 1925, at Brigham City, County of Box Elder
and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melven C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence
Five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Le Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Jefferson Brown Newman
I was convicted under the name of Jefferson Brown Newman
