First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of murder in the first degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of March A. D. 1930, at Farmington County of Davis and State of Utah, in second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene R. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to be executed and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Delbert Emery Green I was convicted under the name of Delbert Green

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
