Application of Joseph C. Stevens, No. 5038

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Issuing fictitious check

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of June A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph C. Stevens I was convicted under the name of Joseph C. Stevens

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
