Application of Conditional Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4 day of Nov. A. D. 1925, at Ogden Utah County of Wilkes and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison for a term of Five years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Burchard Keld.
I was convicted under the name of William Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Esau Walton

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
