First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First degree murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of May
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Natural Life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the state prison

Fourth-Honorable E.A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Gilbert Lang Brighton,
I was convicted under the name of Gilbert L. Brighton

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Angeline Wacaster, Roy Donnell

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE
