Application of GILBERT L. BRIGHTON No. 4093

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a PAROLE
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of MURDER 1st DEGREE

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable EPHRAIM HANSEN presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to LIFE IMPRISONMENT
and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON
(On April 21st, 1931, my sentence was commuted to 20 years)

Fourth--Honorable E. A. ROGERS prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is GILBERT L. BRIGHTON
I was convicted under the name of GILBERT L. BRIGHTON

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: ROY DONNELL and ANGELINE WACASTER

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except None
