Application of Gilbert L. Brighton

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May, A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Life imprisonment; and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Gilbert Lang Brighton

I was convicted under the name of G. L. Brighton

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Roy Donnell.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
