Application of GILBERT L. BRIGHTON No. 4093

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation and termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder, 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of May A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Gilbert Lang Brighton

I was convicted under the name of Gilbert L. Brighton
