

Conditional Termination to Evanston, Wyo.

Salt Lake City, Utah, March 27 1920

Application of George H. Clauson No. 5040

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of June A. D. 1928, at Coalville County of Summit and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge White presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to one to ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth--Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is George H. Clauson I was convicted under the name of George H. Clauson

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except As on record in office
