Application of George E. Smith No. 4987

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of February A. D. 1928, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin D. Harris, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy B. Young, prosecuted the case.
