Application of Warden McMillen No. 5113

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5 day of January
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of Sanpete
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dillworth Wooley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate term 1 to 20 yrs

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred W Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Warden Harry McMillen

I was convicted under the name of Warden McMillen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Geo. Porter & Nick Walker

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except one
Second Degree Burglary
