Application of Warden M. Miller No. 5113

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of January
A. D. 1922, at Went County of Sanpete
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable D. L. Worin presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable J. W. Miller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Warden Thos M. Miller
I was convicted under the name of Warden M. Miller

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: George Porter

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
one Second Degree Burglary
