First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of January

and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Holley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 yrs.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harden Harvey McMillen
I was convicted under the name of Harden McMillen
