Application of Warden McMillen,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary,

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th. day of January, A. D. 1929, at Manti, County of Sanpete, and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Delworth Woolley, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison, for the term of One to Twenty years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Warden McMillen, I was convicted under the name of Warden McMillen.
