Application of Warden H. McMillen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of charge and Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of January A. D. 1929, at Monte County of Sanpete and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Bilworth Worley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate term (1 to 20 yrs.)

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Warden H. McMillen

I was convicted under the name of Warden McMillen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Geo. Brewer

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as records show
