I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of May
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Wasatch
and State of Utah, in 2nd District court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to a term of one to twenty years
for Burglary
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Jean P. Phillip Bassett
I was convicted under the name of J. P. Bassett

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except once in
the state of California for Forgery
