Application of Le Roy Utley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of assault with a deadly weapon

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the eleventh day of February  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence  
not to exceed one year  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Le Roy Utley  
I was convicted under the name of " "

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except -- I served three  
months in the Nevada State Prison fourteen  
years ago on a statutory offense but was  
released as soon as the true facts
