Application of Roy Alstead No. 5045

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of June
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hansen presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Roy Alstead
