First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. P. Rogers prosecuted the case.
