Application of Robert Giles No. 5041

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parol  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of June  
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to not less than one year nor more  
than ten years imprisonment  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Robert Carling Giles

I was convicted under the name of Robert Giles

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: A. R. James, Francis Brown, Robert Trace  
and George Brooks.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except a bove charge.
